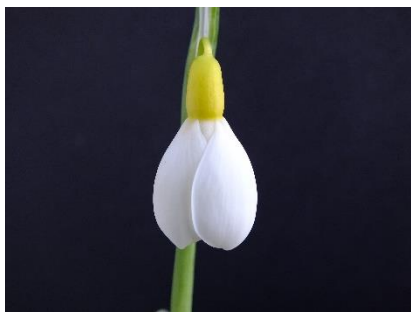

G. 'Rainbow Golden Goblet' Late January - February

A new yellow marked snowdrop with chubby, rounded flowers of good substance. The V-shaped inner segment mark covers about half the segment. The snowdrop is vigorous and large bulbs produce two scapes



G. 'Rainbow Windhover' Mid - Late February

One of the seedlings from a deliberate attempt to produce snowdrops with an arching pedicel using *G. plicatus* 'Percy Picton as one of the parents. We find this form of flower presentation particularly appealing. The snowdrop retains the graceful appearance of the parent but with a distinct inner segment mark. The outer segments are relatively long.



G. 'Rainbow 'Large Icicle' Mid - Late February

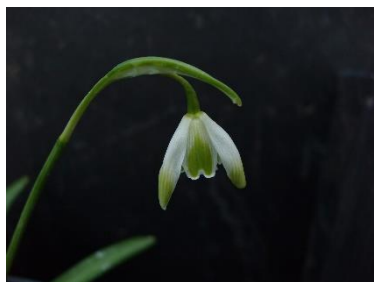
Named for the shape of the inner segment mark that resembles that of G. 'Icicle'. In contrast this snowdrop is taller and has much larger flowers that are held on a long arching pedicel. During research regarding G. 'Icicle' we have found significant variation in photographs claiming to be this snowdrop which suggest that there may be seedling variants of the original in circulation that do not fully match the description given in 'Snowdrops' by Matt Bishop et al.

G. 'Rainbow Pot of Gold' Mid - Late February

A later flowering 'yellow' form of *G. plicatus*. Relatively tall, the flowers are held well above the splayed, semi-prostrate leaves on a sturdy scap.



G. 'Green Spider' Late February - March.

An attractive neat, late flowering, double found in woods at Brabraham in Cambridgeshire. The narrow (spidery) outer segments have a green mark covering about a quarter to a third of the segment from the apex.



G. 'Rainbow Snow Moon' Late February – Mid March

A very vigorous and beautiful late flowering hybrid with nicely textured rounded flowers and faint green lines on the outer segments.

'Rainbow Golden Dart' Mid January

A vigorous snowdrop with a yellow ovary that produces two scapes. The inner mark is a large apple-green acute V with yellow bleeding around the edges fading to yellow-green as the flower matures.



G. 'Rainbow Triceratops' Late February - Mid March

A late flowering hybrid with an unusual inner segment mark comprising a three-pronged apical mark and two long 'eye' marks near the base running towards the apex. Named for the three horned dinosaur.



G. e. 'Mustachio' Mid January - Early February

A tall snowdrop (30 cm) with a distinctive very dark green inner mark comprising an apical mark somewhat resembling a type of moustache and a large rectangular basal mark.

'Rainbow Beaivi' (G. *elwesii*) Late December – Mid January

The second in our 'green goddess' series. An unusual early flowering green marked G. *elwesii*. The flowers are large and have a long ovary and particularly short inner segments. . Named for a goddess associated with the fertility of plants.



'Rainbow Selene' (G. *elwesii*) Late December - Mid January

The third in our 'green goddess' series. The outer segments are often strongly incurved giving them an almost quill-like appearance. Named for the Greek goddess of the moon.



'Isoghem' March

Not one of our selections but a snowdrop now difficult to find in the UK.
A selection we obtained from the Belgian galanthophile Ruben Billet before Brexit.
Sometimes has a 'sail-like' spathe rather than the split form shown in the photograph.
